Senior Women's Golf League
Revised
November 6, 2006



1 Name	Senior Women's Golf League (SWGL)
2 Objective	Promote golf, knowledge of the rules of golf, good sportsmanship, and social activities among the membership.
3 Membership	Open to amateur women golfers who become 50 from December 1 st thru November 30 th . Members are eligible to vote and hold office. Memberships are not transferable.
4 Board of Directors	The Board of Directors shall consist of no more than eight (8) directors and will serve a minimum of two (2) years. A member of the Board of Directors may be removed by a vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the board. Any vacancy may be filled by the President. The Board of Directors must attend two-thirds (2/3) of the scheduled meetings unless otherwise excused.
5 Meetings/Quorum	<p><u>Board of Directors:</u></p> <p><u>Meeting:</u> Will meet once a month with special meetings scheduled as necessary. Any member of the SWGL may attend.</p> <p><u>Quorum:</u> Will consist of a majority of the Board.</p> <p><u>General Membership:</u></p> <p><u>Meeting:</u> There will be a minimum of one general membership meeting held in the fall of each year. Any action taken by the members present at the general membership meeting shall be valid and binding upon the entire membership.</p> <p><u>Quorum:</u> Will be one-fourth (1/4) of general membership.</p>
6 Information/Notices	SWGL will utilize email and our website for information and notices. The website is SWGL's official bulletin board.

7 Elections/Nominations

Members will be given the opportunity to submit an application to serve on the Board of Directors.

The Nominating Chair will submit a list of interested applicants to the Board of Directors no later than the 2nd Monday of September in even numbered years.

The existing Board of Directors will select the candidates for the board vacancies.

The proposed slate will be posted on the website four (4) weeks prior to the general membership meeting.

Approval of the proposed slate will be by voice vote at the general membership meeting.

No absentee ballots will be accepted.

Those elected will assume their duties following the meeting.

**8 Fiscal Year/Dues/
Finance/Audit**

Fiscal year: December 1st – November 30th

Dues: The Board of Directors will recommend annual dues.

Finance: The Treasurer will present monthly financial reports for review and approval at the monthly Board of Directors meetings. The Treasurer will prepare and present the year-end financial reports for review and approval at the December Board of Directors meeting.

Audit: At the discretion of the Board of Directors, an independent audit will be performed of the prior year's financial data. The results of the audit will be presented at the February Board of Directors meeting.

9 Revisions

Proposed revisions will first be presented to the Board of Directors for approval. If the Board of Directors approves the proposed revisions they will be posted on the website four (4) weeks prior to the general membership meeting.

These Bylaws may be revised by two-thirds (2/3) vote of members present at the general membership meeting.
