CHECK IN:

May 18th - 9:00 Shotgun Please check in 45 minutes prior to play.

PRIZE FUND:

You have the option of paying \$5.00 into the prize fund at each tournament. Please bring cash as we cannot accept checks for the prize fund.

CLOSEST TO THE HOLE:

SWGL will pay \$1.00 per participating player into the Closest to the Hole fund for each tournament:
Three places paid up to 90 participants: 50% 30% 20%
Four places paid over 90 participants: 40% 30% 20% 10%

MEMBER GIFT & 2009 ROSTER BOOKLET:

The gift & booklets will be distributed upon check in. For those of you who are not playing you may have a friend pick up your gift & booklet for you or they can be picked up at the next play day.

"MY PLAY DAYS":

Please refer to "MY PLAY DAYS" on the website: www.swgl.org to view your scheduled course(s) and if you've paid your green fee. I encourage you to review this information as someone may have signed you up to play without your knowledge.

CANCELLATION:

If a player must cancel her participation in any tournament, she must notify the Pairings Coordinator – Ginger Salcedo at 324-6913 - a minimum of seven (7) days prior to the Play Day. Please see Cancellation Policy under Standing Rules on the website: www.swgl.org

PACE OF PLAY:

SWGL's goal again this year is to improve Pace of Play. You'll find helpful hints in your roster booklet, but the main one is to keep up with the group ahead of you. We have lots of ladies playing at the courses and need your help in making it a fun day for everyone.
TIP: Putt out – if you're not on someone's line- this will dramatically speed up play

COURSE SELECTIONS:

All courses with the exception of Coyote Moon and Tahoe Donner are now completed. Those who were moved and/or put on the waiting list have been notified. Thank you to everyone for your cooperation and understanding.

ADDING SOMEONE TO YOUR GROUP:

Please do not ask anyone to play in your group if they have not previously signed up. I have ladies on the waiting list and will need to select from them before I add anyone else.

SCORECARDS:

You must turn in your scorecard after each game. We have to post a score for you even if you have disqualified yourself.

GREEN FEES:

WHEN: Friday, May 22nd
TIME: 8:30 Shotgun Arrive 45 minutes prior to play
WHERE: Sierra Sage
FORMAT: Same point system as Team Play, but named Bogey Points after Mike Mitchell's dog
COST: \$37-includes cart - if you walk it will be the senior rate of \$23
HANDICAP: Maximum 40 handicap; need to bring your GHIN # and index so that we can convert them to Sierra Sage's course
OPTIONAL: Prize Fund: \$5 paid to 1/3 of field
Closest to Hole & Chip In's: \$1
